

## **BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING SOUTH JERSEY REGION-SPORTS CAR CLUB OF AMERICA, INC. AUGUST 2015**

The August 2015 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the home of JD King on Wednesday evening, August 5, 2015. The meeting was called to order by Assistant R.E., JD King at 8:45PM.

**Present were:** JD King, Bill VonSuskil, Bill Richter, Matt Wojkowiak, Craig Zane and Sue King. Guests were: Chris Houliaras and Don Colanero.

**Treasurer's Report** – Sue reported a balance of \$42,000.00 in the race account and \$7,000.00 in the operating account.

**Solo Report** – Bill Richter reported on the Battle of the Bay. 70 cars both days with each entrant getting 6 runs both days. This past Sunday's event saw 80 cars entered with each getting 8 runs. Bill made a motion to donate \$500.00 to the Chelsea Little League and \$500.00 to Ernest Coursey's church to support their Back to School endeavor. Second by Matt Wojkowiak. Motion carried. It was suggested that we make a donation to the Mayor's charity. Bill will follow up with the Mayor's office and get that information back to the Board. JD asked if the Solo committee has any needs. It was determined that the truck is in need of new rims and tires; batteries for the radios. Bill purchased buckets that will hold all the equipment needed on the corners.

**Membership Report** – Bill VonSuskil reported that we have 455 members to date. There will be our fifth Saturday radio show to be held on August 29<sup>th</sup>, between 11:00AM and 12:00PM. Bill VonSuskil, Jim Wakemen, Jr., and Bill Richter will be the hosts. Advance Auto will have their car on display at Summer Thunder. Bill is working with Advance Auto to produce a new flyer.

**Race Report** – Don Colanero reported that we put on a great Majors event. Gayle Lorenz sent a letter to our Race Administration Committee which Don will forward to the Board members. In the observers report for this event it was pointed out that there seemed to be some confusion by drivers as to the options listed on the entry form. This will be looked into and the language will be changed to make it less confusing. There was good feedback from the competitors. Don further reported that the entry for Summer Thunder is very light. There will be an announcement on social media encouraging more entries for this event. Chris Houliaras needs names of solo folks who work race events. He will set up an area on the solo entry form for those solo folks who would like to work race events. There was a lengthy discussion on putting on PDX events next year. This will be a winter project as to its feasibility as these types of events are very labor intensive.

**Old Business** - There was a discussion on holding membership meetings at the Go Kart track in Cinnaminson. It was felt that we should continue with this endeavor
