

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

SOUTH JERSEY REGION – SPORTS CAR CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.

APRIL 2016

The April 2016 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the home of J.D. King on Wednesday evening, April 6, 2016. The meeting was called to order by R.E., Jim Tornetta at 8:20PM.

Present were: Matt Wojkowiak, Bill VonSuskil, J.D. King, Sue King, Jim Tornetta, and Craig Zane. Guests were: Bill Richter, Jim Wakemen, Sr., and Nick DiMeo.

Treasurer's Report – Sue reported a balance of \$1,800.00 in the race account and \$1,500.00 in the operating account.

Solo Report – Bill Richter reported that wheels for the solo truck have been purchased. Bill received a quote on tires at \$75.00 each. J.D. stated that he will check with Tire Tech about pricing on tires. Bill further reported that Brandon Hipp is now the waiver chief and Giancarlo Marzan is the worker chief. Bill is looking into the purchase of trophies and additional instructor shirts. There is discussion about putting on a rally cross on August 28th. Because of the instability of Atlantic City, the Solo chiefs are looking at different venues – Rowan College at Gloucester County, Cape May Airport and Millville Airport. Discussion centered on what to name this year's Solo series and 'Bye Bye Bader' was mentioned. Jim Tornetta asked Bill to give him some time at our first event on April 10th to speak about setting ground rules for this year's events.

Rally Report – Jim Wakemen, Sr. reported that the March Lamb/Lion is all set. There is a need for new rallymasters and Jim Sr. is looking for volunteers. The next event is scheduled for September. Jim Sr. further reported that a local Corvette club approached him about putting on a rally for them in May. He will follow up with them.

Membership Report – Bill VonSuskil reported that we have 460 paid members to date. Bill went over upcoming activities – Adopt-A-Road on April 16th at NJMP (Dividing Creek Road). We will meet at Vern's for breakfast at 8:00AM, then do cleanup. There is a car cruise at Shalom Chapel in Vineland on May 14th. Richland Village Community Day is Scheduled for May 21st – bring your race cars and solo cars. Richland Village has many attractions, shops, etc. – there is no vendor fee required. The Vineland Cruise Down Memory Lane will be held on June 11th – we have a booth at this cruise and the vendor fee is \$100.00. The town of Richland will have a cruise which will be held at Michael Debbie Park on July 3rd. Bill is still looking into an Adopt a Barracks at Millville Airport. We have an ad in Cruising Magazine. The Grapevine, which is a local newspaper in Cumberland County, had a write-up about our radio show. Bill further reported that Contes Corvettes, located in Vineland, has offered a 1995 Corvette Indianapolis pace car to be used at the 12 Hour. Marty Pinder, who is the managing partner of Contes Corvettes has approached Bill about a corporate sponsorship in our club. Bill will follow up with Marty. J. D. suggested that we have a presence at the Pumpkin Run which is held the first Saturday in November. Also, the Race of Gentlemen in Wildwood.

Old Business – Jim Tornetta reported that he and Sue King had a meeting with Tom Holding who is the new Director of Motorsports Activities at New Jersey Motorsports Park. The 2016 contracts were gone over. Tom stated that gate entry to our events will be different this year. Volunteers will only have to sign the track waiver at the gate for entry except for the Majors event – volunteers will have to be in before 10:00AM with presentation of their credentials otherwise they will have to pay to enter. Tom asked Jim if we needed a flatbed for the 12 Hour. Jim will check with Ray M. for his opinion and let Tom know by Tuesday, April 12th. Overall, Jim felt the meeting with Tom went well.

New Business - Jim Tornetta reminded all that April 11th is an RPC meeting and April 13th is our membership meeting - both will be held at Uno.

There being now further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:15PM.
