

SCCA Regions Partner To Co-Host the Mid-Atlantic Road Racing Series

The Washington DC and South Jersey regions of the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) are pleased to announce exciting news for Mid-Atlantic area racers, and racers up and down the east coast.

The regions have agreed on a 5-year commitment to co-host the Mid-Atlantic Road Racing Series, aka MARRS.

The 2020 MARRS schedule and championship will feature 9 race weekends held at 4 different tracks. Race weekend formats will consist of qualifying, heat races, and feature races. Points towards the prestigious MARRS championship honors are awarded in all heat and feature races.

“The co-hosting partnership and schedule is big news for racers – bringing more excitement to the MARRS series and making the MARRS championship one of the most coveted regional racing championship honors in the US,” said Bob Crawford, Director of Road Racing for the Washington DC Region SCCA.

The series gets off to a strong start in April with round 1 at Summit Point Motorsports Park April 4-5, followed by round 2 at New Jersey Motorsports Park’s Lightning circuit on April 18-19. The full schedule is below.

More big news for endurance racers and teams, the regions have announced the return of The Devil In The Dark 12-Hour endurance race. Beginning October 23-24 2020 at NJMP’s Thunderbolt circuit, The Devil will alternate between NJMP and Summit Point each year.

“We hear from many racers passionate about the excitement, challenge, and teamwork associated with endurance races. It’s really exciting to have the 12-Hour return to the schedule for the next 5 years , and to offer teams the opportunity to compete to be the best on two different tracks,” said Nick DiMeo, South Jersey Region’s Competition Chairman.

Nick added, “WDCR & SJR are working together and with other regions and organizations to expand the reach of the 12-Hour attracting more racers and sponsors, making this endurance event one of the most sought after wins in North America. “
