BRANDYWINE MOTORSPORT CLUB and SJRSCCA present **MARCH LAMB XI**. This event is sponsored by the rally cooperative consisting of the organizations listed above. The **MARCH LAMB** automobile road rally traverses roads through Cecil Co. MD, Chester Co., PA and New Castle Co., DE. Average speeds are at or below the posted limits. A challenge will be offered in most legs to correctly apply the rules of the rally (General Instructions/GIs). It is very important to pre-register in order to receive the GIs and prepare ahead of time. It is even more vitally important for this event since it is a course following event where the correct course or timing is often determined by correct application of the GIs. We suggest that you visit the website ([www.phillyscca.com](http://www.phillyscca.com)) and review the tutorial regarding the T-Rule & Protection Rule (Identified as Lesson #1). A **Touring Rally** course is also provided using straight-forward instructions and combined classes using a handicap system.

### Registration and Start:

PARK-N-RIDE lot appx. 1/2 mile north of I-95 & State Route 896 in Newark, DE. at the intersection of SR 896 & SR 4.

### Finish:

Matilda's Restaurant, about 1/4 mile from the start location.

### Awards:

Top 25% in each class. Class X may be formed from SCCA E, L, S for trophy awards as defined in the General Instructions.

### Schedule:

Registration Opens 11:00 AM  
Rally School 11:45 – 12:00  
First Car Starts 12:30 PM  
Awards After Scoring Done

### Equipment

As defined for SCCA Classes E, L, S. Novice Class must conform to SCCA Class S.

### Participants:

A minimum and maximum of two persons per car is allowed. Small children are excepted but all minors are required to have a Minor Release Form signed by parent or guardian. (in advance)

### Classes:

SCCA Classes E, L, S are provided. Additionally a Novice Class (N) is offered for entries with neither team member having >10 events experience: using SCCA Class S equipment. Sole entry in a class will result in combining using a handicap.

General Instructions will be e-mailed to all competitors whose pre-paid entry is received by March 22nd. Advanced registration and receipt of General Instructions gives you the rules for the rally.
